

Biodiversity Statement

The conservation of biodiversity is an integral part of Lundin Petroleum's commitment to environmental protection.

Lundin Petroleum recognises the need to conserve biodiversity - ecosystems and living organisms such as animals, plants, genes and their habitats - in the conduct of its exploration and production operations. It is particularly attentive to rich or fragile biodiversity areas such as forests, deltas, mangroves, coral reefs, water bodies and protected areas as defined by IUCN, UNESCO and RAMSAR.

The Company supports the objectives expressed in the Convention on Biological Diversity, especially the conservation of biological diversity, and its strategic goal to improve the status of biodiversity by safeguarding ecosystems, species and genetic diversity.

Lundin Petroleum integrates biodiversity in its environmental management planning and decision making processes, undertaking environmental baseline studies and environmental impact assessments, engaging with local residents and biodiversity experts, and contributing to R&D and organisations working on the conservation of biodiversity. It is committed to avoid, minimise, restore or offset potential impacts resulting from its activities and to make a positive contribution to biodiversity conservation throughout the life cycle of its projects.
