Lundin Petroleum AB ("Lundin Petroleum") has entered into a two year rig contract in partnership with Marathon Petroleum Company (Norway) ("Marathon") to contract the Songa Dee semi submersible rig from Songa Offshore ASA. The rig utilization will be shared on a 50:50 basis between Lundin Petroleum and Marathon. The contract will commence in late 2008/early 2009 and includes options for further extensions of up to one year. The contract value for the firm period is approximately 310 MUSD. This rig contract will allow Lundin Petroleum to further pursue a proactive exploration and appraisal strategy on the Norwegian Continental Shelf.
